FoodLab Chicago 6.0 is an educational training program designed for food based businesses who are looking to take their businesses to the next level. Since its launch, FoodLab Chicago has assisted 85 Chicago food-based businesses. Selected participants have received \$6.2 million in grants and loans and increased their profits with menu engineering from 3% to 38%.

FoodLab Chicago focuses on supporting BIPOC food service entrepreneurs who have been operating for at least 12-18 months, are generated sales, and are located in Chicago.
